To, All Range Deputy Inspector General of Police, Orissa including DIG Crime (Local) and DIG CR Cuttack (Local), I.G. Rly, Cuttack (Local).

Sub: Supply of booklets regarding guidelines adopted by the NHRC on arrests.

Book-lets containing guidelines of NHRC regarding arrest in English and Oriys are sent herewith for circulation amongst all Ss.P. and Investigating Officers and other staffs in your Range. You are requested to enforce the guidelines as per the following directions of the NHRC.

Guidelines must receive maximum publicity in the print or other electronic media. It should also be prominently displayed on notice board, in more than one language, in every police station.

The police must set up a complaint redressal mechanism which will promptly investigate complaints of violation of guidelines and take corrective action.

The notice board which displayed the guidelines must also indicate the location of the complaints redressal mechanism and how that body can be approached.

NGO's and public institution including Court, Hospital, Universities-etc. must be involved in the dissemination of these guidelines to ensure the widest possible reach.

The functioning of the complaint redressal mechanism must be transparent and its reports accessible.

Prompt actions must be taken against the errant Police Officers for violation of the guidelines. This should not be limited to departmental enquiries but also set in motion the Criminal Justice Mechanism.

Sensitisation and training of Police Officers is essential for effective implementation of the guidelines.

In case of shortfall of the booklets you are requested to take steps to print them and circulate amongst the staffs under your disposal and to depute a Spl. Messenger to this office to collect booklets.
