of Trust and 8.2 per cent cases of Cruelty by Husband or Relatives were found false or related to mistake of law, as a result, no charge-sheet could be laid in such a large number of cases as compared to 4.2 per cent cases found false or those relating to mistake of law in all the IPC cases at national level.

Appendix B:

Excerpt from Chapter 4, page 3

4.9. There were 69,91,508 cases for trials (including pending cases from the previous year) during 2005 as compared to (67,68,713) during the previous year 2004. The percentage of cases for trial has increased to 14.5 per cent in 2005 from 14.1 in 2004. At the end of the year, 83.3% IPC cases remained pending for trial in various Criminal Courts of the country. This signifies the enormity of pendency in trials of criminal cases in various Courts in the country. It is evident that the trials conducted by the Criminal Courts have not kept pace with new institutions. This problem needs to be addressed on priority basis.

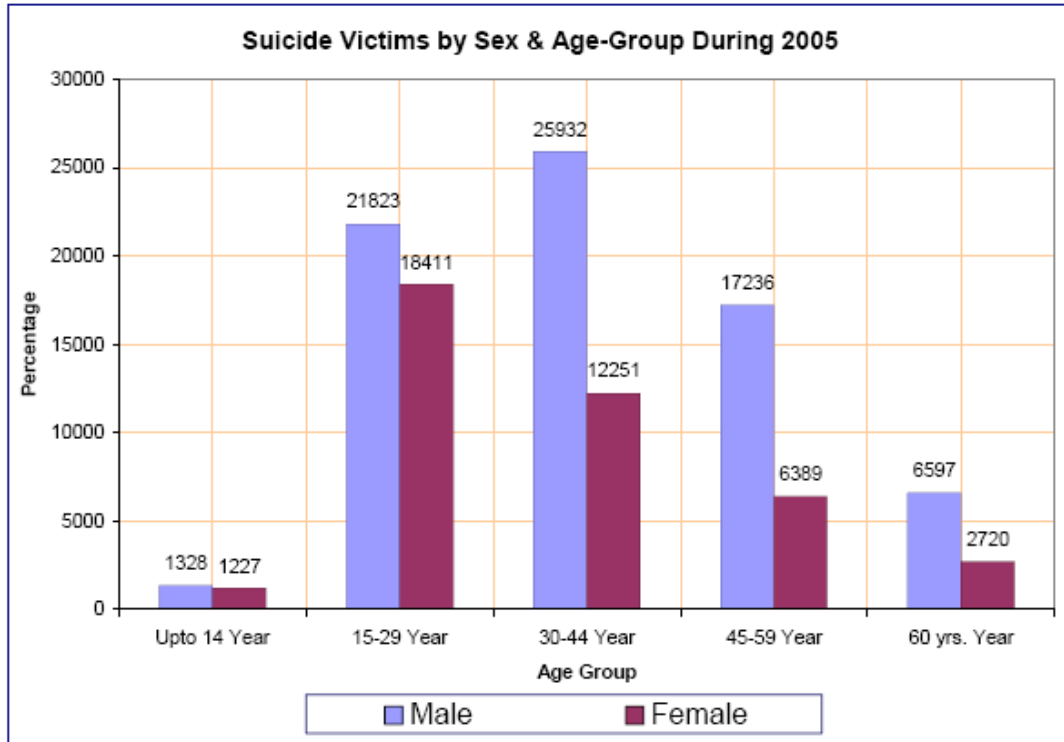
